

Prohibited Feed Affidavit

Affidavits are required annually from each supplier of protein supplements, including those used in total mixed rations or protein supplement blocks, cubes, pellets or liquids. This affidavit is not necessary for grain and forage (hay, silage or bedding) that has not been further processed and contains no additives.

Keep all affidavits for two years on file at the beef cattle operation.

This affidavit, or alternatively a corresponding letter, is a requirement of the Verified Beef Production™ program. The purpose is to increase the profile of the importance of managing feed with ruminant protein (non-cattle feed) and avoiding inadvertent cross-contamination. We thank you for your support.
